The principal Conditions affecting Contract Tickets are as follows:—

- Contract Tickets which are available for one return journey each day may be used only between 0730 and 0930 and between 1530 and 1800 on ordinary school days or from school if leaving earlier on production of an authorisation signed by the head teacher.
- Contract Tickets which are available for two return journeys each day may be used only between 0730 and 0930 between 1145 and 1400 and between 1530 and 1800 on ordinary school days or from school when leaving earlier, on production of an authorisation signed by the head teacher.
- Contract Tickets issued for use on Saturdays may be used between 0730 and 0930 and 1145 and 1300 when it is necessary for the holder to travel to school for any purpose. In such event the Contract Tickets are available for one journey in each direction only.
- Contract Tickets are not available on Sundays or during School holidays.
- Contract Tickets which are purchased from the Transport Department Offices are entitled to be held only by a person under 15 years of age who is receiving whole time instruction at a recognised educational establishment, but should the holder attain the age of 15 years during the school term, the Contract Ticket will be available until the end of such Term.
- Contract Tickets are not available for Students or Apprentices.
- On every occasion when travelling on a vehicle with a Contract Ticket, it must be shown to the Conductor.
- Contract Tickets must be produced for inspection on demand by any officer or servant of the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department. If not produced when required, the holder shall be deemed not to have paid a fare for that particular journey and such fare shall be recoverable by the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department from the holder. No refund of such fare will be made.
- A lost Contract Ticket must be reported immediately to the Office of the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department, and if not found within one week from the date of which it was reported lost, a duplicate may be issued at the discretion of the General Manager, on payment of 13p and in the meantime, the ordinary fare must be paid.
- Contract Tickets are the property of the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department and must be surrendered to the Office immediately on expiration.
- The holder of a Contract Ticket is not entitled to a refund under any circumstances, but refunds may be made at the discretion of the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department.
- Contract Tickets are not transferable.
- Contract Tickets are liable for forfeiture if there be a breach of any of the conditions of issue or the general regulations of the Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department.
- The Borough of Chesterfield Transport Department may decline to issue or renew any Contract Ticket.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE AND PASSENGER REGULATIONS

(Unless expressly stated otherwise the following Conditions apply to the Department's Stage Carriage Services, Express Carriage Services and Contract Carriages).

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS

The Department expects to maintain its services shown in its time-tables but reserves the right without previous notice to the Public, temporarily or permanently to alter, suspend, withdraw, cancel or deviate the route of any vehicle or service or alter all or any of the operating times of the services. The Department further gives notice that it does not undertake nor by the publication or display of this or any timetable, timetable sheet, handbill, advertisement, destination notice or other notice or ticket is to be deemed to offer or undertake that its vehicles shall depart or arrive at the time or places advertised or at all or that any connection shall be maintained or that there shall be accommodation available upon any vehicle or that any vehicle shall stop when called upon to do so by any person. The Department will not be liable for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience which may be sustained by any person through the alteration, suspension, withdrawal, cancellation or deviation of any vehicle or service or through the failure of any vehicle to perform its service or to stop when called upon to do so or to depart or arrive at the times advertised or at all or through any lack of accommodation, detention, delay, early running or want of punctuality or through the display of any incorrect or misleading destination notice.

2. FARES

Persons boarding a vehicle between fare stages will be charged from the previous fare stage. Persons alighting between fare stages will be charged to the fare stage beyond.

3. CHILDREN'S FARES (EXCEPT SERVICES 36, 11, 12 and 512)

Children under 5 years of age, if not occupying a seat, shall be conveyed free of charge provided not more than one such child accompanies any adult fare-paying passenger or adult pass-holder. Additional children, irrespective of age, must be paid for.

Children at 5 and under 15 years of age, and additional children as above, provided they do not occupy a seat required by an adult fare-paying passenger, will be charged as follows:—

ADULT FARE	CHILDREN'S FARE
5p	3p

and thereafter at half the Adult Fare calculated on the basis that fractions of 1p be charged as 1p.

4. DOGS

Dogs, accompanied by passengers and kept under control, are allowed to travel in buses at the conductor's discretion, on the following conditions: A fare-paying passenger or pass-holder is allowed to bring only one dog, which must be paid for as under:—

and thereafter at half the Adult Fare calculated on the basis that fractions of a penny be charged as a penny, subject to the maximum charge of:—

REGISTERED GUIDE DOGS

Registered Guide Dogs are allowed to travel free on the Department's routes, including routes operated jointly with other transport undertakings, when accompanied by their blind owner. The owner should have an authority issued by the Guide Dogs for the Blind Association Limited, certifying that the dog is a registered guide dog.

5. TICKETS

(1) No passenger shall use or attempt to use

- Any ticket which has been altered or defaced with Intent to avoid payment of a fare, or,
- Any ticket which has been issued to another person, if such ticket bears thereon an indication that it is not transferable.

(2) Passengers on paying a fare, are requested to see that they receive a ticket, issued in their presence, corresponding with the amount paid. Tickets must be retained and produced when requested by an authorised official, or the conductor. If not produced when requested, full fare must be paid which is not subject to any refund.

(3) Where a through service is provided, no change of vehicles is permitted, nor does any ticket permit a break of journey at intermediate points.

(4) No passengers shall leave or attempt to leave a vehicle without payment of fare for the journey taken and with intent to avoid payment thereof.

6. Passengers are advised not to board or alight from the vehicles whilst in motion and the Department cannot be held responsible for injuries to passengers resulting from these causes.

Passengers wishing to alight must notify the conductor of their intention to do so.

Passengers shall not—

(1) Enter or remain on a vehicle when requested not to do so by an authorised person on the ground that the vehicle is carrying its full complement of passengers.

(2) Travel in or on the upper saloon of a vehicle unless occupying a seat provided for the purpose, nor remain on the platform steps, or staircase.

(3) When the vehicle is in motion distract the driver's attention or speak to him without reasonable cause.

(4) Wilfully remove, displace, deface, or alter any number plate, notice board, fare table, route indicator, or any printed or other notice or advertisement, or equipment on the vehicle.

(5) Remain on the vehicle when it reaches the terminus on being requested to leave by the driver or conductor.

(6) Spit upon, or from, or wilfully damage, soil or defile any part of the vehicle.

CONDUCT OF PASSENGERS

The attention of passengers is directed to the Public Service Vehicles (Conduct of Drivers, Conductors and Passengers) Regulations, 1936, made by the Minister of Transport.

7. LOST PROPERTY

The Department shall not be responsible for loss or damage to any article left by passengers in any public service vehicle.

Regulations have been made by the Minister of Transport under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, dealing with property left on public service vehicles.

Any person who finds any property accidentally left in one of the Department's vehicles should immediately hand it as he finds it to the conductor, who will hand it to the Transport Offices unless it is properly claimed before he has an opportunity to do so.

When any property is claimed by a person, the representative of the Department may require the claimant to open any receptacle in which it may be contained and submit the contents to examination for the purpose of establishing his or her claim to ownership, and to pay a fee in accordance with the appropriate Lost Property Regulations.

Enquiries should be made at the Lost Property Office, Stonegravel Depot, Sheffield Road. Office Hours Monday to Friday, 0900 to 1300 hrs., 1400 to 1700 hrs.

8. LUGGAGE

Passengers travelling upon any vehicle may take with them personal luggage without charge. All such luggage is carried at the responsibility of the passengers, and must not occupy any part of a seat, nor be of a form or description, such as to cause annoyance or inconvenience to other passengers.

On all vehicles, all luggage, boxes, parcels, etc. are carried entirely at owner's risk, and the Department accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any loss thereof, or damage thereto, however caused.

The Department reserves the right to refuse to carry luggage of dangerous or offensive nature.

TRAVEL CONCESSIONS FOR ELDERLY PERSONS

Concessionary travel for residents within the Chesterfield Borough is available for women over the age of 60 and men over the age of 65 not in full-time employment and in receipt of a contributory retirement pension or widows' benefit or supplementary pension from the Department of Health & Social Security, and to Disabled Persons who are registered with the Derbys. C.C. Social Services.

Tokens to the value of £10.00 per year will be issued to suitably qualified persons upon application being made at the Transport Dept. Offices on Sheffield Road. **The Pension Order Book must be produced** on making application. The tokens are available for use at any time on any day of the week and may be used on all services, including jointly operated services. **FULL FARE** must be paid with the tokens which can be tendered singly or in multiples or as part of a fare together with other coins of the realm. Where the value of the tokens presented is in excess of the fare required, change must be given.

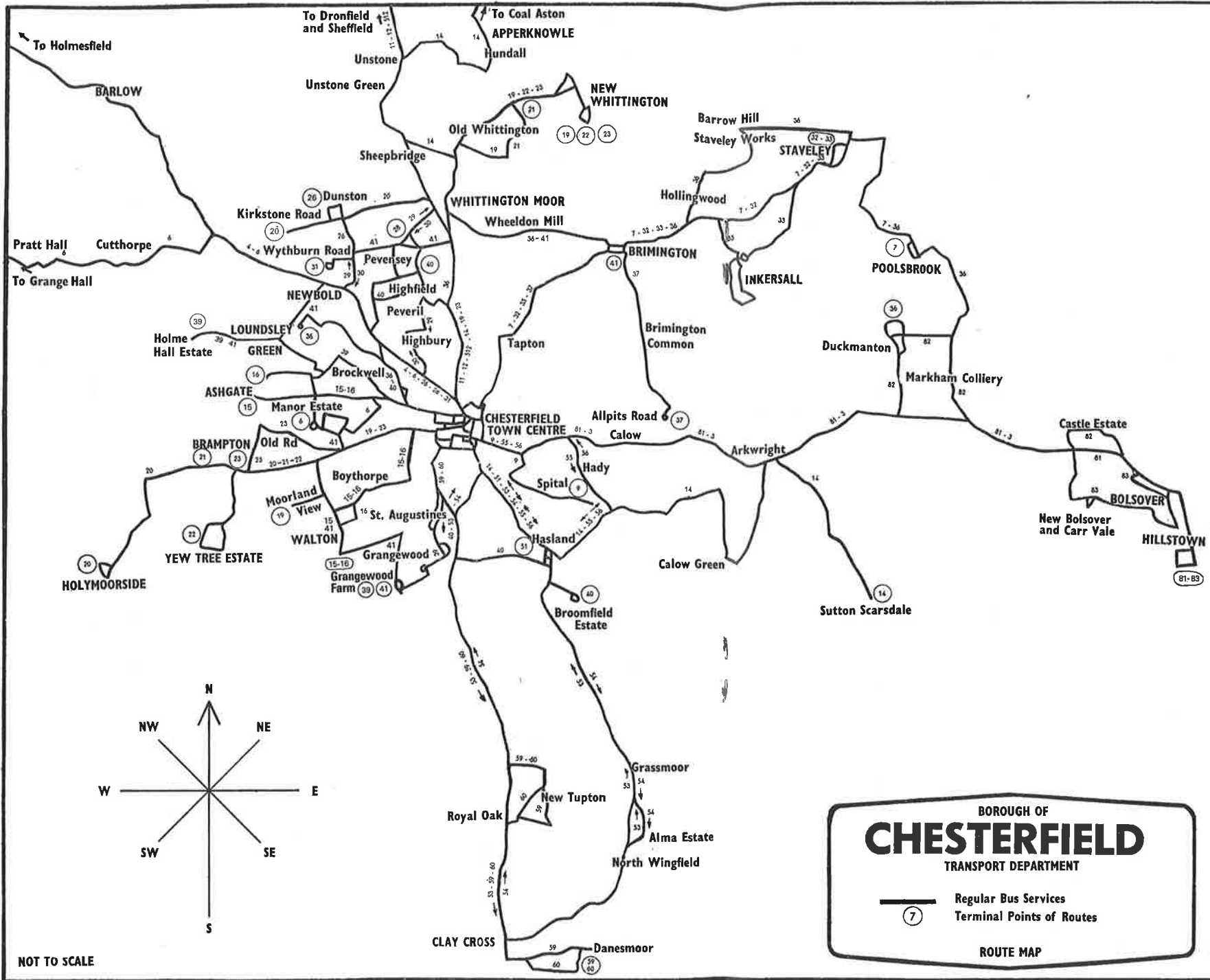
